Concordance Results Using KJV

Strong's Number **G40** matches the Greek ἅγιος (*hagios*), which occurs 229 times in 219 verses in the Greek concordance of the KJV

Outline of Biblical Usage

- the third person of the triune God, the Holy Spirit, coequal, coeternal with the Father and the Son
 - sometimes referred to in a way which emphasises his personality and character (the "Holy" Spirit)
 - sometimes referred to in a way which emphasises his work and power (the Spirit of "Truth")
 - never referred to as a depersonalised force
- the spirit, i.e. the vital principal by which the body is animated
 - the rational spirit, the power by which the human being feels, thinks, decides
 - the soul
- a spirit, i.e. a simple essence, devoid of all or at least all grosser matter, and possessed of the power of knowing, desiring, deciding, and acting
 - a life giving spirit
 - a human soul that has left the body
 - a spirit higher than man but lower than God, i.e. an angel
 - used of demons, or evil spirits, who were conceived as inhabiting the bodies of men
 - the spiritual nature of Christ, higher than the highest angels and equal to God, the divine nature of Christ
- the disposition or influence which fills and governs the soul of any one
 - the efficient source of any power, affection, emotion, desire, etc.
- a movement of air (a gentle blast)
 - of the wind, hence the wind itself
 - breath of nostrils or mouth

Concordance Results Using KJV

Strong's Number **G4151** matches the Greek πνεῦμα (*pneuma*), which occurs 385 times in 350 verses in the Greek concordance of the KJV

- **Who is the Holy Spirit?**
 - The Holy Spirit is the third title of the Godhead. The Holy Spirit is the indwelling Spirit of God (the Creator), the Spirit of the resurrected Christ! – I John 5:7
- **What is the Holy Spirit? What does the Holy Spirit do?**
 - His is a Comforter and the Spirit of Truth – John 14:16-18
 - Lead, guide direct in all truth – John 16:12-15
 - Keeps you from falling – Jude 1:24 – 25; 2 Timothy 1:14
 - The Holy Spirit is a gift. – Luke 11:9 – 13
 - The rhema or revelation of God’s Word and direction for your life – Luke 2:26
 - Helps you deal with your thoughts and body to live holy – Acts 9:31; I Corinthians 6:18-19; Hebrews 3:7-19
 - Bringing all holy things back to your remembrance – John 14:26
 - Tell you what to say, when to say it and how to say it – Mark 13:11; Luke 12:12
 - Boldness – Acts 4:31
 - Wisdom, Honesty, Anointing for Business – Acts 6:3
 - Joy – Acts 13:52; Faith – Acts 11:24; Hope that will not make you ashamed & Love – Romans 5:5
 - Power – Romans 15:13; Acts 2:38
 - Sanctification – Romans 15:16
- **Where does the Holy Spirit live or reside?**
 - In your spirit. The Holy Spirit regenerates or takes over you old spirit man. – John 14:17
- **When do you receive the Holy Spirit?**
 - At the moment of salvation, there is an operation of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit regenerates or makes alive your inner spirit, which died at the moment the first Adam disobeyed God in the Garden of Eden. – Romans 8:9-11
 - The baptism of the Holy Spirit is the manifestation of speaking in other tongues. – Acts 2:1 – 21;
 - You can receive the operation and baptism of the Holy Spirit simultaneously or concurrently. You can receive the Holy Spirit at any time of day or night and anywhere! God is omnipresent, He is everywhere at any and every time!
 - Do you have to be saved in order to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit?
 - Saul and the company of the profits – I Samuel 19:23 – 24
- **Why do I need the baptism of the Holy Spirit?**
 - The believer needs the Holy Spirit to live an effective and holy lifestyle.
 - Promise of God – Matthew 3:11; Mark 1:18; Luke 3:16; John 1:33; Acts 1:8; Acts 2:38 – 41
 - Abundant life – John 10:9 – 11
 - Wisdom – 1 Corinthians 2:12 – 14
 - The Holy Spirit gives the believer power to resist and when necessary, fight the enemy. – Mark 12:36
- **How do I receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit with evidence in speaking in other tongues?**
 - Mode: The believer receives the Holy Spirit as a gift with humility and by faith. – Luke 11:9 – 13; Acts 15:8; Hebrews 6:4
 - Method: You can receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit in different ways.
 - Prayer – Acts 8:15
 - Laying on of hands – Acts 8:17
 - Jesus breathed on the disciples – John 20:19 – 23
- **How do you use the Holy Spirit?**
 - In prayer and intercession – Romans 8:26-27; I Thessalonians 5:16-18; I Timothy 2:8; Matthew 26:41; Romans 1:9
 - In praise and worship – Luke 10:21; Philippians 3:3
- **How often should you speak in other tongues?**
 - Build yourself up daily – 2 Corinthians 13:14; Jude 1:20
- **Why is there a delay in the manifestation of the Holy Spirit with evidence in speaking in other tongues?**
 - There is something in some area of your life, hindering you. There may be an open gate to the enemy or an area of your life that you have not totally surrendered to God. – Acts 7:51
- **How do you know when the Holy Spirit is speaking?**
 - The believer will know the voice of the Holy Spirit because it will always line up with the Word of God.
 - You can hear the voice of the Holy Spirit through the preached word of God, reading the word of God.
 - The still small voice of the Holy Spirit within you matures, the more you partake of the Word of God.
