Mid-Week Prayer & Bible Study “Effective Prophetic Prayer” By Prophet Inez Brewington

- Praying the past and cliché does not work. We need to pray prophetic prayers, we should pray it forward. The old deacon prayers may have worked then but this is a new day. There has been revealed a new and better way.
- **What makes prophetic prayer effective?** Faith makes it effective! The word makes it effective!
- **So what is prophetic praying?**
 - It is when you use revelation from the Holy Spirit in praying.
 - It is the unveiling or the release information in the form of a prophecy, a picture vision, idea or scripture.
- **There are at least 4 types of prophetic prayers:**
 1. **Receiving** - Hearing the Holy Spirit speak wisdom or knowledge and then you pray what He says.
 - *The Spirit shares prophetic revelation with us as we wait on God in prayer**
 2. **Interceding** - Hearing what the Holy Spirit is saying for someone else, then pray it as He gives it to you.
 - *We use the prophetic revelation we have received to remind God of His promises**
 3. **Warfare** - Hearing what the Holy Spirit is saying concerning high powers, demonic oppression, principalities, strongholds etc. and then pray as you hear.
 - *We use prophetic revelation to wage spiritual warfare and make powerful proclamations**
 4. **Impartation** - Hearing what the Holy Spirit is saying concerning His Will is important to a believer who is present, then praying that which you hear.
 - *God uses us to pray prophetically as we minister in prayer to others**
- **Scriptures:**
 - **Luke 18:1** - *And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;*
 - **James 5:16** - *Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.*
 - **NOTE:** The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man AVAILETH. PRAY IT FORTH!
- **ACTIVATION:** "Prime your pump" Stir up the gift that is within by praying I the spirit.
 1. Start by praying slowly and at normal volume.
 2. Increase within 2 min. Use the terms "basement to penthouse". Increasing the volume and intensity brings excitement and enthusiasm for the anticipated prayer.
 3. Go quiet. Listen to what the Spirit is speaking to you and then pray it out loud.

- **What is prophetic prayer?**
 - **Prophetic prayer occurs when we use revelation received from the Holy Spirit in the process of praying.**
 - *The New Testament Greek word translated ‘revelation’ means ‘unveiling.’ **The Holy Spirit shares knowledge that we could not know by natural means.** We then reflect that supernatural insight back to God in requests, intercession and proclamation.*
 - *A revelation from God may come in the form of a prophecy, picture (vision), dream, idea, or scripture. However, there are a myriad of creative ways that the Holy Spirit can speak to us if we are open to hearing His voice.*
 - **We can also pray prophetically without it being premeditated on our part.** During or after the prayer we realize that the Holy Spirit has directed us how to pray.
- *The power of this kind of prophetic prayer can be summed up by these words from the Bible:*
 - **1 John 5:14-15**
This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us-whatever we ask-we know that we have what we asked of him.
- *We can use the prophecies, scriptures, and other revelations we have received to declare God’s purposes for their lives and to pray against demonic strongholds (2 Corinthians 10:4-6).*
 - **II Corinthians 10:4 – 6 (KJV)**
⁴ (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)
⁵ Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;
⁶ And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.
